RCC board ready to send \$60.3 million bond to ballot

The Rogue Community College Board of Education is set to approve placing a \$60.3 million bond on the November ballot.

The school says it needs the money to increase workforce capacity, improve safety and security at all three campuses, and modernize the student success center and classrooms at the Riverside campus in downtown Medford.

It also would pay for accessibility improvements at all three campuses, improvements to HVAC, energy efficiency and roofs at certain buildings, and pay for new furnishings and equipment.

The college's last bond, approved in 2016, was for \$20 and paid for a number of projects, including the new science building at the Redwood Campus in Grants Pass.

The school says it expects the state to provide \$15 million in matching funds.

The bond tops the agenda of the RCC board's public meeting at 5 p.m. Tuesday at the Riverside Campus, Room 129 in the Higher Education Center.

It also will be livestreamed on Zoom, webinar ID 933 0075 1708.
