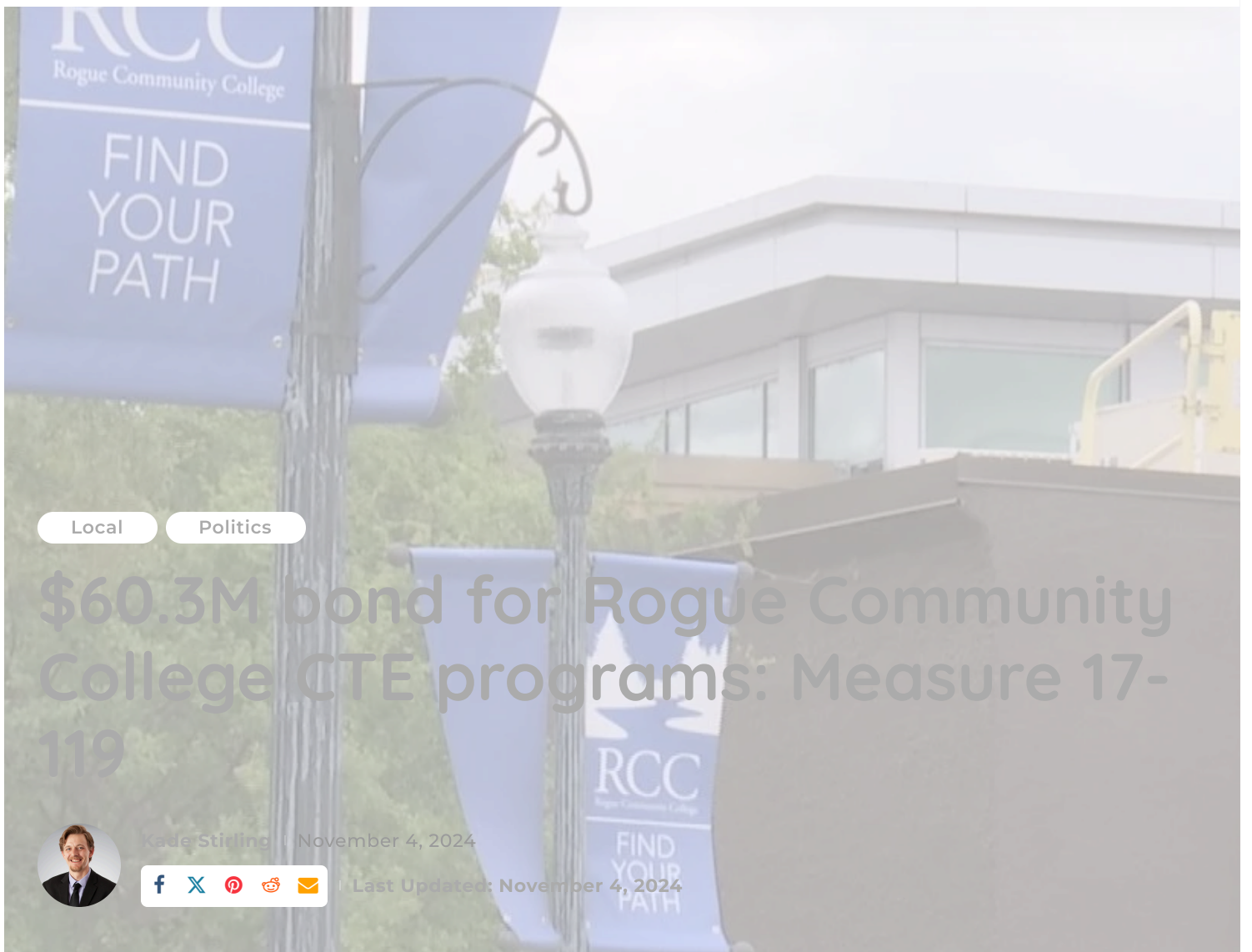

\$60.3M bond for Rogue Community College CTE programs: Measure 17-119

JACKSON/JOSEPHINE COUNTIES, Ore. – A \$60.3 million bond measure on the ballot in Jackson and Josephine counties aims to fund various projects across Rogue Community College campuses in both counties.

If approved, Measure 17-119 would support the expansion and improvement of career technical education programs, including welding and nursing; while introducing EMT and diesel technology to the Redwood campus in Grants Pass.

Additional funds would go to improvements to Medford's Riverside campus.

To pass, the measure requires a majority from the combined district spanning both counties.
