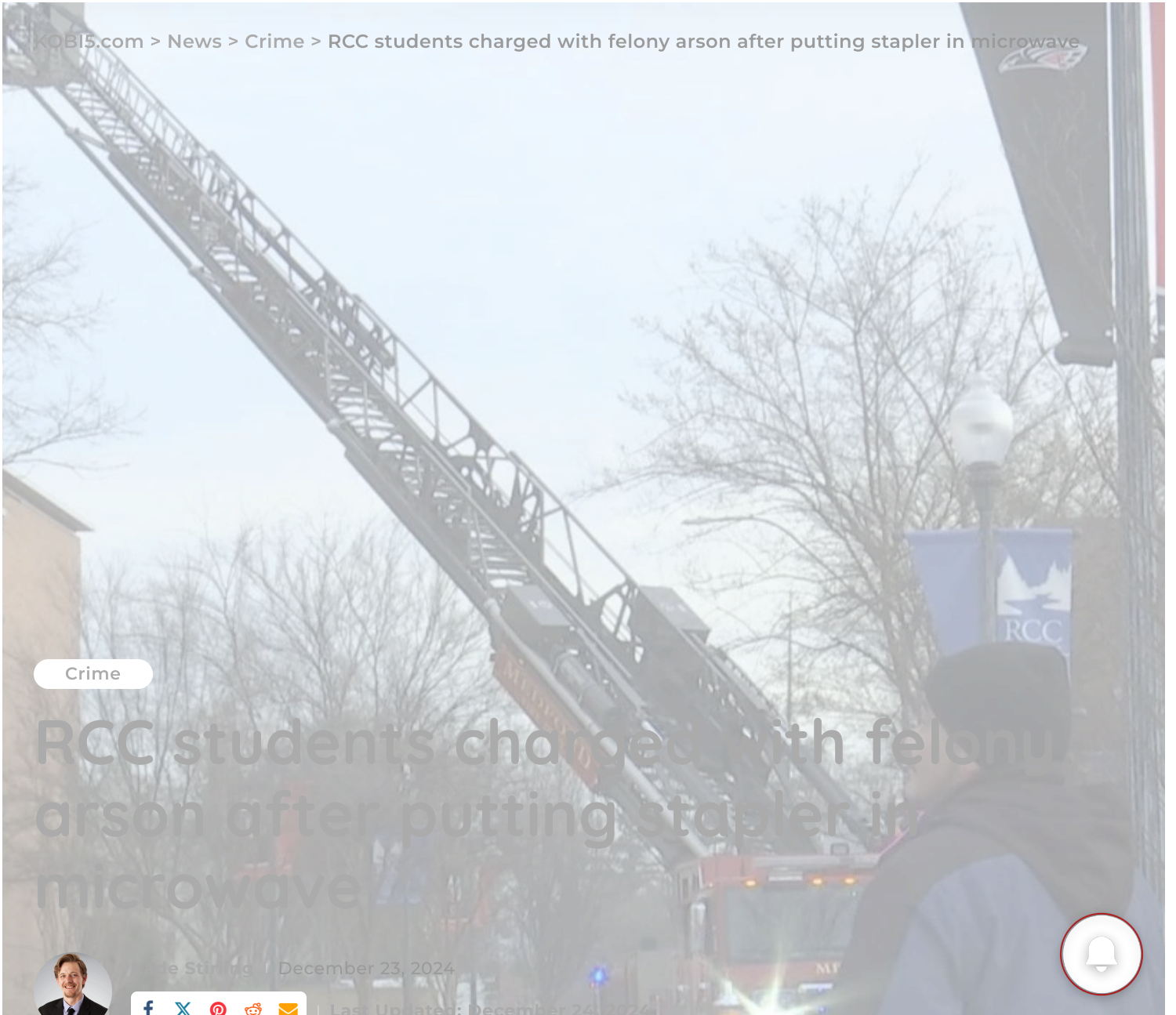

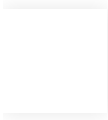
# RCC students charged with felony arson after putting stapler in microwave

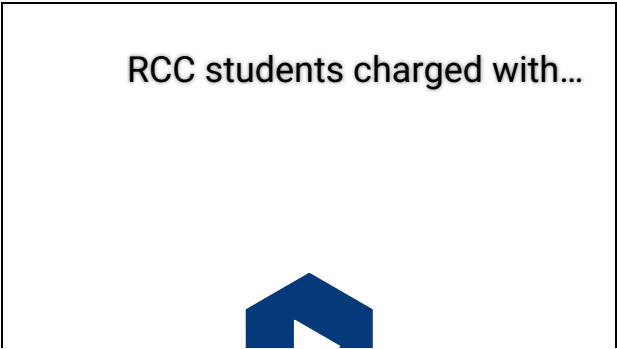

MEDFORD, Ore. – Two Rogue Community College students are being charged with felony arson after allegedly putting a stapler in a microwave, leading to the evacuation of the Medford campus last Wednesday, December 18.

According to Jackson County court documents, Nathan Svinth and Christian McLennan intentionally started the fire, causing damage to the building located at 101 S Bartlett St in Medford.

The pair are charged with arson in the first degree, which could result in up to 90 months in prison as well as recklessly endangering another person.
